FACT SHEET: THE NEW INTERACTIVE WEBSITE FOR LABOUR MARKET STATISTICAL INFORMATION

The Ministry of Manpower's Research and Statistics Department will be launching a free service for employers and employees to benchmark their organisation's performance against the national or industry norms on wages, employment conditions and staff turnover. Companies that participate in the national manpower surveys would have their results automatically populated for them to compare against the benchmark of their choice through **AutoBenchmark**, which is one of the world's first offered by a national manpower statistical agency.

This new benchmarking service is part of the Ministry's efforts to extend the sharing of data beyond the standard statistical releases, by enabling employers and employees to learn where their organisation stands against the national or industry norms. Along with the new service, the Ministry's Labour Market Statistical Information website would be transformed to enhance the public's online engagement with the Ministry.

The new interactive Labour Market Statistical Information website features the following:
